Bursary Summary: to assist students who are members of the ISAP, who have had papers accepted for formal presentation at the Archaeological Prospection conference in Rome 2005 and need help towards the cost of attending the event. There is no restriction as to country of residence. There will be a number of bursaries offered at £100 per award.

- The application must be made on the prescribed form as soon as possible following receipt of notification that the paper or poster has been accepted by the Conference Organising Committee.
- Bursaries are open to students who are ISAP members and have had papers accepted for formal presentation at the Archaeological Prospection 2005.
- An award may only be used in support costs directly associated with attendance at the event. The value of each award will be £100. The number of bursaries available is limited.
- Applications must be made on the prescribed form and submitted to ISAP via the Archaeological Prospection 2005 conference organizing committee.
- ISAP will withhold the bursaries if no suitable applicants are forthcoming.
- The applicant must immediately notify ISAP if unable to attend the event for which a bursary has been requested.
- The bursary will be given in person to the successful applicant(s) at the Archaeological Prospection 2005 conference. The bursary is not transferable to another conference.
- A bursary will be withdrawn in the event of a paper for presentation being rejected.
- The decisions reached will be regarded as final and no further correspondence relating to the allocation of awards can be entered into after the awards have been announced.
