Bursary Summary: to assist students who are members of the ISAP, who have had papers or posters accepted for formal presentation at the Archaeological Prospection conference in Paris 2009 and need help towards the cost of attending the event. There is no restriction as to country of residence. There will be a number of bursaries offered at 200 Euros per award.

- Bursaries are open to students (Undergraduate, Masters or PhD/Doctorate) who are ISAP members and have had papers accepted for formal presentation at the 8<sup>th</sup> International Conference on Archaeological Prospection 2009.
- The value of each award will be 200 Euros. The number of bursaries available is limited.
- The application must be made on the prescribed form as soon as possible following receipt of notification that the paper or poster has been accepted by the Conference Organising Committee.
- The application form **must** be accompanied by a short supporting letter from the student indicating why they should receive this award.
- The application form and supporting letter shall be emailed to the address given on the form by the deadline stated.
- ISAP will withhold the bursaries if no suitable applicants are forthcoming.
- The applicant must immediately notify ISAP if he/she is unable to attend the event for which a bursary has been requested.
- The bursary will be given in person to the successful applicant(s) at the 8<sup>th</sup> International Conference on Archaeological Prospection 2009 in Paris. The bursary is not transferable to another conference.
- A bursary will be withdrawn in the event of a paper for presentation being rejected.
- The decisions reached will be regarded as final and no further correspondence relating to the allocation of awards can be entered into after the awards have been announced.
