The bursary is to assist students and early-career young professionals who are members of ISAP and need financial assistance towards the cost of attending an event that is explicitly supported by ISAP.

- These bursaries are open to students (Undergraduate, Masters or PhD/Doctorate) and early-career young professionals who are ISAP members with a current paid subscription. Early-career young professional will normally have graduated within the last three years and be currently on a junior salary scale. ISAP may contact their line manager to confirm the latter.
- In case that the event to be supported is a conference, applicants should have had a paper (oral or poster) accepted for formal presentation. If at the time of application a decision about the acceptance has not yet been reached, applicants should try to obtain an informal statement from the conference organisers. Should the paper subsequently be rejected or the applicant not attend the event, the bursary may be withdrawn. The applicant must immediately notify ISAP if she/he is unable to attend the event for which a bursary has been requested. The bursary is not transferable to another event.
- If further conditions for the award of the bursary have been advertised, these will form part of the selection criteria.
- The value of each award is as advertised and the number of bursaries available is limited.
- The application must be made on the prescribed form by the advertised closing date. It is
 essential to provide a supporting statement in the relevant box explaining briefly why ISAP should
 support the applicant.
- The application form shall be emailed to the address given on the form by the advertised closing date.
- ISAP will withhold the bursaries if no suitable applicants are forthcoming.
- If awarded, the bursary will be paid preferably as a bank transfer, and bank details will hence have
 to be provided to ISAP. In exceptional cases it may be possible to provide a cash payment at the
 funded event. The applicant is responsible to confirm details with ISAP.
- The decisions reached will be regarded as final and no further correspondence relating to the allocation of awards can be entered into after the awards have been announced.
